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## US Pain Foundation 2022 Patient Survey

# Executive Summary

This report presents a validation study comparing simulated survey data generated by Simsurveys against published results from the US Pain Foundation's 2022 "A Chronic Pain Crisis" survey. The original study surveyed 2,275 chronic pain patients recruited from the US Pain Foundation community between March 29 and April 12, 2022. It is one of the largest patient-reported surveys on chronic pain management, provider relationships, and treatment barriers in the United States.

A principled subset of 17 questions was selected across three thematic clusters: Mental Health & Stigma (4 questions), Patient-Provider Relationship (7 questions), and Treatment Experience (6 questions). Questions were selected by cluster rather than individually to avoid cherry-picking bias. All questions are single-select. One question (Q38) uses a filtered base of opioid users only.

Simsurveys generated 2,275 synthetic respondents using its consumer simulation model with custom demographic quotas matching the original study's population: 87% female / 13% male, age distribution skewing 45–64 (62%), and suburban-majority location (52% suburban, 26% rural, 20% urban). Targeting criteria described the respondent profile as chronic pain patients with long-duration, high-impact pain who are active in treatment and engaged with pain advocacy communities.

Alignment is assessed using Kullback–Leibler (KL) Divergence, which measures distributional similarity between published and simulated response distributions. All 17 questions are single-select, so KL divergence is the appropriate metric. KL values below 0.15 indicate strong distributional alignment where insights from simulated data would lead to substantively equivalent conclusions as the published data.

The model demonstrates strong alignment on binary questions (average KL ~0.02 for stigma and treatment questions) and correct directional ordering across all questions. The primary systematic pattern is over-estimation of symptom frequency for anxiety and depression (Q19/Q20), and central tendency bias on ordinal provider-relationship scales where the model gravitates toward middle options and underweights extremes. These patterns represent calibration opportunities rather than fundamental model limitations.




## How often do you feel anxiety-like symptoms?


## How often do you feel depression-like symptoms?


## Do you feel stigmatized because of pain?


## Do you feel stigmatized by your health care providers?


## Are you currently seeing any health care professional for pain?


### Does your current HCP help you understand different options for managing your chronic pain?


### Do you feel your current HCP listens and validates your symptoms, concerns, and pain?


### Do you feel comfortable discussing new treatments with your current HCP?


### Do you feel you are a team with your current HCP when it comes to managing your chronic pain?


### How much do you trust your providers' ability to manage your pain?


### Are you hopeful that you will achieve the goals of your pain management plan?



## Do you currently take opioid medications?



## Have you faced barriers to obtaining your opioid medications?




## Have you ever signed a pain contract?


## Have you ever been asked to take a urine drug test (UDT)?
